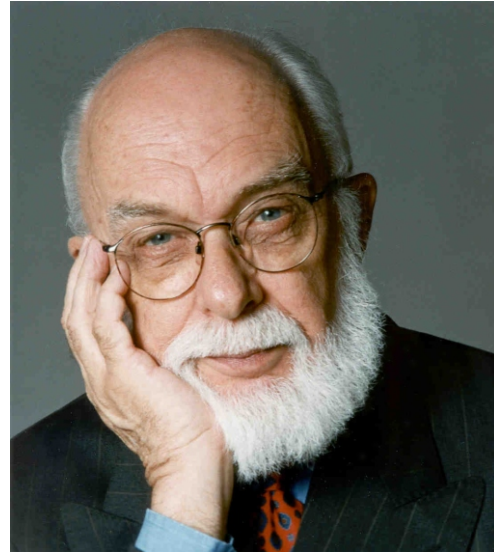


James Randi

The world's most amazing investigator and demystifier of paranormal and pseudoscientific claims is our honored guest for this 20th anniversary meeting of the National Capital Area Skeptics.

James Randi has pursued "psychics", exposed the dirty tricks of faith healers, investigated homeopathic water "with a memory," and generally been a thorn in the sides of those who try to pull the wool over the public's eyes in the name of the supernatural.

He has received numerous awards and recognitions, including a Fellowship from the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation in 1986.

In 1996, the James Randi Education Foundation was established to further Randi's work. Randi's long-standing challenge to psychics now stands as a \$1,000,000 prize administered by the Foundation. It remains unclaimed.
